The Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC) has studied the risk factors and needs of Juvenile Court-involved youth in this county and hereby publishes this Request for Proposals. The JCPC anticipates funds from the NC Dept. of Public Safety in the amount stated above to fund the program types specified below. Such programs will serve delinquent and at-risk youth for the state **fiscal year 2014-2015** beginning on, or after, **July 1, 2014**. The use of these funds in this county **requires a local match** in the amount specified above.

The JCPC will consider proposals for the following needed programs:

Sex Offender Evaluation & Treatment	Individual, Family & Group Counseling	Mediation/Conflict Resolution
Psychological Assessments	Parent/Family Skill Building Programs	Emergency Shelter Care
Substance Abuse Counseling	Interpersonal Skill Building Programs	Foster Care
Substance Abuse Assessments	Group Home Care	Home Based Family Counseling
Restitution/Community Service	Clinical Evaluations	Mentoring

Proposed program services should target the following risk factors for delinquency or repeat delinquency:

* Substance Use/Abuse * Serious School Problems * Parent/Guardian/Custodian supervision skills

*Pro-Social peer rejection and youth association with others who are involved in delinquent/criminal activity.

Programs should address the following concerns as reported in the Needs Assessments for adjudicated youth:

Peer Domain: Alexander County youth involved with juvenile justice system associates with others who are involved in delinquent/criminal activity.

Individual Domain: Juveniles involved in the Alexander County juvenile justice system have a higher rate than state average of juveniles that need further substance abuse assessments..

Family Domain: Parental Support and/or parental enhancement skills needed for juvenile court referred youth. Access services that provide best practices and have the ability to engage families in the community.

School Domain: Youth involved with the Alexander County juvenile justice system have increased risk of school behavior issues reflected in long-term suspensions.

Applicants are being sought that are able to address items below:

1. Program services compatible with research that are shown to be effective with juvenile offenders.
2. Program services are outcome-based.
3. The program has an evaluation component.
4. Program services detect gang participation and divert individuals from gang participation.

Local public agencies, 501(c)(3) non-profit corporations and local housing authorities are invited to submit applications to provide services addressing the above elements.
