

What To Recycle at Convenience Centers

Glass

- All clean beverage and food containers
- Rinse out and remove lids, paper labels do not need to be removed
- Please sort by color
- **No glass from baking dishes, drinking glasses, or windows can be recycled**

Aluminum/Metal Cans

- Beverage, food, juice containers, aluminum foil, and pie pans
- **Rinse out, paper labels do not need to be removed**

Cardboard

- Pizza, cereal, and shoe Boxes
- Any corrugated cardboard
- **Please breakdown boxes**

Newspaper/Magazines/Mixed Paper

- Newspapers, inserts, magazines, and phonebooks
- Computer paper, mixed colored paper, envelopes, wrapping paper, shredded paper, etc.

Plastics

- Plastic bottles numbered 1-7
- Soda, Clorox, fabric softener, milk, and condiment containers
- Any bottle with a snap or screw-off lid
- Make sure container has recycling symbol with number 1 -7 on it
- Plastic Bags need to be bagged and placed in with plastics
- **Rinse out, remove lids, and flatten**

Pesticide Containers

- **Containers must be emptied and triple rinsed**
- Will not accept any container that is unclean or have liquid in them
- Remove lid, but labels may be left on

Petroleum Products

- Motor oil, hydraulic oils, and transmission fluids are accepted
- **No solvents, gasoline, antifreeze, paint, or chemicals are acceptable at convenience sites.**

What To Recycle At The Landfill

Automotive Recycling

- Motor oil, hydraulic oils, and transmission fluids are accepted
- Car batteries are recycled at the Landfill only
- Antifreeze can be recycled at the landfill only
- Oil filters are recycled at the landfill and must be drained
- **All Automotive recycling is free of charge**

Tires

- Alexander County residents can dispose of five tires per year free of charge
- **Contact the Solid Waste Department if you have more than five tires to dispose of, a small tire clean up can be arranged**

Yard Waste

- Leaves and grass are accepted free of charge
- Brush is accepted at \$25/ton

Pallets and Clean Wood

- Pallets and clean wood are accepted at \$25/ton, this is a reduced rate to encourage citizens to keep these materials separated
- Clean wood consists any untreated, or unpainted wood
- No OSB or plywood

White Goods

- Refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, water heaters, air conditioners, etc.
- **White goods are accepted free of charge**

Electronics

- Electronics can now be recycled at the Landfill and Convenience Centers
- Items that can be recycled include:
 - o All computer equipment, including monitors
 - o Video and stereo equipment
 - o Telephones, fax machines, and cell phones
 - o Printers and copiers
 - o Televisions larger than a computer monitor must go to landfill
- This is only a partial listing; if it plugs in we can recycle it!
