GENERAL PARK RULES

- No glass containers or bottles
- No tobacco products
- No alcohol unless sold at an event
- No firearms, knives, or weapons of any kind
- No unauthorized amplified music
- No skateboards, skates, rollerblades, scooters, hover boards, bicycles, or similar recreation equipment
- No foul or abusive language or bullying
- Pets must remain on a leash at all times. No pets allowed in Splash Pad.
- No loitering or soliciting
- No person shall lie or sleep on seats, tables, or benches
- Any guest violating venue policy or law will be ejected from the venue at the sole discretion of venue management or law enforcement
- Blankets are welcome and lawn chairs are allowed
- All bags, coolers, and outside materials are subject to search and seizure of contraband items
- Tents are allowed with a Special Event Permit from Alexander County

Instructions for Hosting a Special Event in the Park

(As defined in the Alexander County Special Event Ordinance)

- Reserve the Park for your event by contacting 828-352-7757
- Complete and submit a Special Event Permit Application for approval by the Alexander County Event Review Committee.
- Once your Event Permit has been issued, you may promote your event to the public.
- All events are rain or shine; there are no refunds for bad weather on day of the event.

SPLASH PAD RULES

- ALL GENERAL PARK RULES APPLY
- Splash Pad may be closed at any time due to weather, maintenance, or other operational concerns
- Please enjoy the Splash Pad at your own risk
- NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY
- Toddlers must wear swim diapers
- No pets are allowed in the Splash Pad
- Never leave children unattended – Adult supervision is required for children aged 12 and younger (One adult for every four children)
- No running or rough play
- No foul/abusive language or bullying
- Food, drink, sippy cups, bottles, or wrappers shall be permitted only in Picnic Shelter area of the Splash Pad
- No tobacco products may be brought into the Splash Pad area
- No water balloons, water guns, floats, personal chairs, or other toys allowed
- No skates, skateboards, scooters, or bicycles allowed
- No bathing, soap, detergent, or shampoo allowed
- No mud, sand, or debris is allowed in the Splash Pad area
- No glass objects of any kind in the Splash Pad area
- Persons having an infectious or communicable disease or open cuts or sores shall be excluded from the Splash Pad
- Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose, or drinking the Splash Pad water is strictly prohibited
- Appropriate clothing or swimwear is required
- Water footwear is strongly recommended
- PLEASE DO NOT DRINK THE WATER
- Respect others
- Maximum occupancy is 50
