The meals and incidental expense (M&IE) breakdown in the table below is provided in case a traveler needs to deduct meals included in a registration fee from their M&IE allowance.

Meals provided by a common carrier or a complimentary meal provided by a hotel do not affect per diem.

Incidental expenses as described by GSA include items such as tips given to baggage carriers and hotel staff.
