FY 2025 Per Diem Rates for North Carolina

Meals & Incidental Expenses (M&IE) rates and breakdown

The M&IE total is the full daily amount for a single calendar day when that day is neither the first nor last day of travel. The amount received on the first and last day of travel equals 75% of the M&IE total.

The meals and incidental expense (M&IE) breakdown in the table below is provided in case a traveler needs to deduct meals included in a registration fee from their M&IE allowance.

Meals provided by a common carrier or a complimentary meal provided by a hotel do not affect per diem.

Incidental expenses as described by GSA include items such as tips given to baggage carriers and hotel staff.
